Your organization is required to file an annual financial report with the Attorney General's Charities Bureau. Reports are due within four and one-half months after the organization's fiscal year ends.

Your organization's reporting period and the date on which its next report is due are shown above.

Pursuant to Article 7-A of the Executive Law, if your organization fails to file an annual report, your organization's Article 7-A registration to solicit contributions in New York shall no longer be in effect and your organization may be subject to the imposition of fines of up to \$1000 per violation and \$100 per day that such violation continues. Pursuant to the EPTL, any trustee who fails to file financial reports with the Attorney General may be fined \$10 per day, up to a maximum of \$1000, for each such failure.
